Greetings fellow undergraduate philosophers,

We are delighted that you are considering submitting your work to our journal. The deadline for submission is **Friday, November 21st**, with selectees being notified in January. Submissions will be reviewed on a rolling basis meaning that early submissions have a distinct advantage. That said, if your paper is in progress and you would benefit from an extension, please email the editor, Trevor Jennings, at jtrevor@sas.upenn.edu and we will accommodate you as best we can.

We welcome submissions of original, unpublished, undergraduate work from every branch of philosophy. Submissions should be no longer than 6000 words (approx. 15 single-spaced pages), with the “sweet spot” being 4000-5000 words. All submissions should be prepared for blind review by being stripped of all identifying information such as author name and university affiliation. Citations should be made according to the 16th Edition of the *Chicago Manual of Style*. Submissions should include three attachments:

1. A pdf file of your submission (only title, body, and citations).
2. A matching editable text file of your submission.
3. A cover sheet with your name, essay abstract, university affiliation, and email.
