



Eleventh Annual Goucher College Philosophy Conference

VERITAS: the Philosophy Club of Goucher College, in collaboration with the Goucher Philosophy Department, invites submissions by undergraduates for our tenth annual conference to be held on **Saturday, April 5, 2014**

Keynote Speaker: James Risser is Professor of Philosophy at Seattle University. He received his Ph.D. from Duquesne University in 1978. Professor Risser is the former Executive Co-Director of the Society for Phenomenology and Existential Philosophy (SPEP) and currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Collegium Phaenomenologicum. Professor Risser is an internationally recognized scholar in the area of aesthetics and 19th-20 continental philosophy. His published works include *Hermeneutics and the Voice of the Other: Re-reading Gadamer's Philosophical Hermeneutics* (1997), and *The Life of Understanding* (2012). He is the editor of *Heidegger Toward the Turn: Essays on the Work of the 1930s* (1999), coeditor of *American Continental Philosophy* (2000), and Associate Editor of the journal *Research in Phenomenology*.

Submission Guidelines:

- Papers can be on any philosophical topic
- Papers should be a maximum of 12 pages (for a twenty-minute presentation)
- Paper format: 12-point, double-spaced, Times New Roman, 1-inch margins
- Students may submit more than one paper for consideration
- Please prepare for blind review: remove all contact information and identifying marks from the body of the paper
- Please fill out a cover sheet and submit it, with your finished paper, to veritas@goucher.edu by **March 1, 2014** (if submitting more than one paper, please include additional cover sheets for each paper)
- Your cover sheet must include the following: Name, Email, Phone, School, Title of Submission, and a 3-5 Sentence Abstract
